



## ***Policy for Responsible Stewardship of the Environment***

The Silver Spoon Company is committed to sustainable sourcing of all key commodities including packaging from regions not implicated in poor human rights and environmental standards including deforestation. We recognise that some essential commodities and packaging used for our products may be linked to regions with unsatisfactory Standards (social, environmental and deforestation). We plan to use our influence to drive positive change where possible.

In line with our Sourcing with Integrity Policy which is shared with all our direct suppliers, we will seek to source raw materials from suppliers who:

- Uphold our values
- Demonstrate transparency and welcome inspection of their processes
- Are subject to recognised third party certification Standards and Chain of Custody validation.

We will endeavour to use primary Packaging Materials sourced from suppliers certified to Forestry Stewardship Council (FSC) Standards. Where there is no negative impact on food safety, quality and legality, secondary packaging materials incorporating recyclable material will be utilised.

The Silver Spoon Company believes that environmental protection is everyone's responsibility within the business and supply chain. The Company will continue to undertake risk assessment, monitor and mitigate non-compliance issues as much as possible across the supply chain in order to minimise ethical and environmental impact across its operations.
